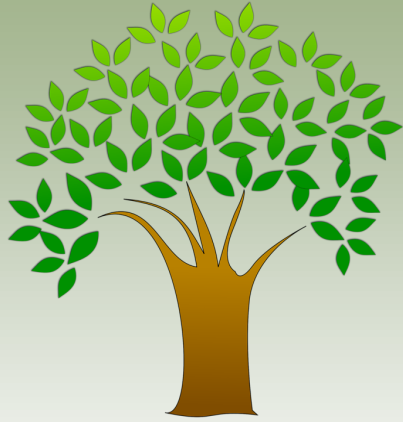

What is a CAC?

- CACs were created through NYS General Municipal Law Article 12-F section 239-x.
- It is a council consisting of 3 –9 people who meet regularly to discuss environmental issues related to the town.
- This council serves as an advisory board that advises the town on environmental issues affecting the community.

What does the Hyde Park CAC do?

- Reviews plan submissions for environmental concerns and makes comments to the planning board.
- Educates the community on preserving natural resources, sustainability and conservation.
- Maintains natural resource inventory maps of the municipality.
- Advises municipality and provides support for current environmental issues.
- Helps to protect natural resources.
