**RESOLUTION 3:31 - 1 OF 2021**

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TOWN OF HYDE PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT POLICE REFORM COLLABORATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, Governor Cuomo has issued Executive Order 203, which provides, in relevant part, that each local government entity which has a police agency must perform a comprehensive review of current police force employments, strategies, policies, procedures and practices and develop a plan to improve such practices for the purposes of addressing the particular needs of the community served by such police agency and promote community engagement to foster trust, fairness and legitimacy and to address any racial bias and disproportionate policing of communities of color; and

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order 203 further provides that each executive of such local government shall convene the head of the local police agency and stakeholders in the community to develop such plan and consider evidence based policing strategies, which are stated in the memorandum entitled: “Dutchess County Police Reform and Modernization Collaborative”; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board, by Resolution 1:25-15 of 2021 established the Police Reform and Modernization Collaborative Committee pursuant to the provisions of Executive Order 203 and the Dutchess County Police Reform and Modernization Collaborative memo; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee worked to accomplish the goal of creating defined objectives and plan for adoption by the Town Board in accordance with Executive Order 203 and the memorandum annexed thereto and submitted the “Town of Hyde Park Police Department Police Reform Collaboration Plan” to the Town Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board reviewed the said Plan and determined that the same was acceptable for purposes of public review; and

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order 203 requires, in relevant part, that such Plan be offered for public comment to citizens in the Town prior to presentation to the Town Board for adoption of the Plan either by local law or resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board duly noticed and conducted a public hearing on the adoption of the said Plan on March 22, 2021 at 6:05 p.m. and accepted public comment on the Plan for a period of seven (7) days after the close of said meeting.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Board hereby adopts the Town of Hyde Park Police Department Police Collaboration Plan dated January 2021; and

**RESOLUTION APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) IN CONNECTION WITH THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE HYDE PARK CSEA HIGHWAY UNIT**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Hyde Park is a party to a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the Town of Hyde Park CSEA Highway Unit; and
